Master of Public Administration at DCAS

The Public Administration Program of LIU Brooklyn's School of Business, Public Administration and Information Sciences, in cooperation with the City of New York, offers courses leading to a Master of Public Administration (M.P.A.) degree – the management degree for public service professionals in the public, health and non-profit sectors. This flexible, "fast-track" program offers courses at two convenient locations, at a special reduced tuition.

Academic Program

The 48-credit, 16-course, M.P.A. degree consists of six core management courses, four advanced function courses, four concentration courses and two capstone courses. Thirteen courses (36 credits) are available off-campus, with attendance at LIU Brooklyn for Computer Applications, Research Methods, Capstone Seminar and Capstone Project necessary to fulfill state residency requirements.

Class Schedule

Courses meet in seven-week "fast track" modules Wednesdays, from 5:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m., or Saturdays, from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Courses are sequenced so that students' progress without interruption once they begin. The M.P.A. degree is attainable in two years by attending two classes per semester (two days a week) on Wednesdays and Saturdays, and during summers or three years at one course per semester one day per week.

Location

All off-campus courses are available at the DCAS Citywide Training Center (1 Centre Street, 24th Floor, lower Manhattan).

Tuition

Courses are offered at one-third off the current LIU Brooklyn graduate tuition rate. Tuition can be paid by check or credit card. Union tuition reimbursement may also be available for eligible employees.

Registration and Application Process

Registration occurs on-site at the beginning of your first semester and on-line thereafter. Texts are available at LIU Brooklyn's bookstore or on-line from other sources. Students must also be admitted to LIU. Graduate admission forms are available at LIU Brooklyn's Admissions Office, (718) 488-1011, or from DCAS, (212) 669-3630, or on-line at <http://liu.edu/Brooklyn/Admissions/Graduate>. Admission requires an official undergraduate degree transcript from an accredited institution, two letters of recommendation and the application fee. GRE or GMAT scores are not required. However, students must attend writing and quantitative skills workshops for two full consecutive days.
