Job Description

Under supervision, the selected candidate will conduct inspections of air and noise pollution sources to ensure compliance with laws, rules and regulations, and reduce or eliminate conditions contributing to air pollution, such as excessive air contaminants or excessive noise; and perform related work. Responsibilities will also include investigating complaints alleging emissions into the atmosphere, improper operation of equipment, and loud sound levels from sources including machinery, instrument, amplifiers, etc.; and interviewing complainants for verification of complaints and instructing owners, lessees, agents and building superintendents in appropriate action to correct conditions; serving summonses, testifying in court and assisting in the preparation of evidence. Selected candidate will also use Micro-Ringlemann chart, and other devices; seal equipment under direction and prepare reports of inspection activities.

Qualification Requirements

A four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent.

Certificate Requirement

Within three years of appointment to Air Pollution Inspector Assignment Level I or to be appointed directly to Assignment Level II, candidates/incumbents must possess an acceptable Visible Emissions Certificate and an acceptable Urban Noise Course Certificate. These certificates must be maintained for the duration of employment.

License requirement

Within six months of appointment to Assignment Level I or to be appointed directly to Assignment Level II candidates/incumbents must possess a motor vehicle driver's license valid in the State of New York. This license must be maintained for the duration of employment.

Probationary Period for Assignment Level I

Appointments to Assignment Level I of this position are subject to a minimum probationary period of three years.

Requirements for Assignment Level II

- a. Upon satisfactory completion of three years of training and service as an Air Pollution Inspector Assignment Level I, employees who possess a driver's license valid in the State of New York, a visible Emissions Certificate and an Urban Noise Course Certificate shall be assigned to Assignment Level II.
- b. To be appointed directly to Assignment Level II, candidates must have, in addition to meeting the minimum qualification requirements, the certificate and license requirements set forth above, and three years of full-time satisfactory experience in the inspection, operation, testing, designing or the maintenance of equipment that may emit air contaminants and /or excessive noise from such sources as the following: air cleaning, fuel burning, industrial processing, incinerating, or electrical or acoustical equipment.
