Example of a legal buck's antlers

These antlers have three points on at least one beam, and each point (excluding brow tines) is at least 1 inch long. A buck with antlers like these may be harvested on the Quality Deer Management Areas after the first two days of each season.

Example of a legal buck's antlers

These antlers have a spread of less than 15 inches, but because at least one beam has three points, not counting brow tines, that are 1 inch long or greater, it may be harvested.

Examples of illegal bucks' antlers

These antlers either do not have three points of one inch or more on a side or the antler spread is less than 15 inches.
