JOB DESCRIPTION

The Painter will work on and from ladders, platforms and scaffolds as jobs may require; erects ladders; rig lines and scaffolds; prepares, fills, and primes surfaces for painting; mixes paint components and matches colors; applies paint with a brush, roller or spray gun to surfaces; applies plaster to surfaces including skimming walls and taping joints; takes proper care of all materials, tools and equipment; keeps work records as required; may operate a motor vehicle in the performance of assigned duties.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Five years of full-time satisfactory experience as a painter acquired within the last fifteen years; or
2. At least three years of experience as described in "1" above and sufficient full-time satisfactory apprentice painter experience to make up a total of five years of acceptable experience. Six months of acceptable experience will be credited for each year of apprentice painter experience.

PREFERRED SKILLS:

A Motor Vehicle Driver License valid in the State of New York. This license must be maintained for the duration of employment.

NOTE: New York City residency is required within 90 days of appointment. However, City employees in certain titles who have worked for the City for 2 continuous years may also be eligible to reside in Nassau, Suffolk, Putnam, Westchester, Rockland, or Orange County. ****Please note that only candidates considered for an interview will be contacted.****

TO APPLY:

To be considered for appointment, candidates must have taken exam #4012 on January 28, 2014, or those who are already permanent in the Painter title. Please indicate in your cover letter whether you have taken this exam or are already permanent in the Painter title. If you do not include this information in your cover letter, you will not be considered for an interview. Applicants who took an exam will be required to produce a copy of their Order Confirmation Receipt for verification if contacted for an interview.
