JOB DESCRIPTION

Under general supervision or direction, the candidate will overhaul, repair and maintain engines, motors and motor power equipment, component assemblies and component systems, used in all Homeland Security funded fire apparatus, ambulances and support vehicles; perform related work.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Five years of full-time satisfactory experience acquired within the last fifteen years as an auto mechanic; or
- Not less than two and one-half years of full-time satisfactory experience as specified in "1" above acquired within the last ten years plus sufficient helper or apprentice experience or relevant education acquired in a trade or vocational high school or technical school approved by a States Department of Education recognized accrediting organization, to make up the equivalent of five years of acceptable experience. Six months of acceptable experience will be credited for each year of helper or apprentice experience or relevant education.

License Requirements

At the time of appointment candidates must possess a New York State Class B Commercial Driver License ("CDL") or a Motor Vehicle Driver License valid in the State of New York and a Learners Permit for a Class B Commercial Driver License. Appointees hired with a Learners Permit must obtain the Class B CDL within six months of appointment. The CDL, with no restrictions that would preclude the performance of Auto Mechanic work, must be maintained for the duration of employment.

At the time of appointment, certain agencies may require appointees to possess one or more of the following New York State Certifications:

- As a Motor Vehicle Inspector certified in Light Vehicles, Group 1
- As a Motor Vehicle Inspector certified in Heavy Vehicles, Group 2
- As a Motor Vehicle Inspector certified in Motorcycles, Group 3
- As a Motor Vehicle Inspector certified in Emissions, Group D

NOTE: New York City residency is required within 90 days of appointment. However, City employees in certain titles who have worked for the City for 2 continuous years may also be eligible to reside in Nassau, Suffolk, Putnam, Westchester, Rockland, or Orange County.

TO APPLY:

To be considered for provisional appointment, candidates must have filed and sat for exams #6012 OC & #6509 Promotional that was scheduled on January 30, 2016, or those who are already permanent in the Auto Mechanic title. Please indicate in your cover letter whether you have taken any of these exams or are already permanent in the Auto Mechanic title. If you do not include this information in your cover letter, you will not be considered for an interview. Applicants who took an exam will be required to produce a copy of their Order Confirmation Receipt for verification if contacted for an interview.
