Following along 65th Street to 8th Avenue, along 8th Avenue to 61st Street and up to 4th Avenue. From said territory to downtown Manhattan bounded on the north by Delancey Street/Kenmare Street from Lafayette Street to Essex Street. Bounded on the east by Essex Street from Delancey to East Broadway.
