The applicant was advised that sidewalk cafes are not permitted on the Westside of 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue, according to Department of City Planning Zoning regulations. The applicant agreed to limit the number of tables to only those planned for the 48<sup>th</sup> Street side.

Under this condition, the full Board approved this application at its June 5, 2002 meeting.
