The Bureau of School Health-Office of School Health (BSH-OSH) provides direct school health services to over 1.3 million general education school children in this city. JOB DESCRIPTION:

You will perform tasks related to the development of computer and data transformation activities on Medical and School Health data; develop, implement, enhance, maintain and analyze software systems; assist Senior Developer with programming new modules for operations programs, and electronic health records applications in a web environment; utilize several of the following concepts/technology, Web-based application development (ASP.NET), XML, XSLT, database management systems (RDBMS), Transact SQL and Javascript; review and develop detail system specifications and modify existing applications to accommodate changing business objectives; work with Senior Developer and DBA to define the infrastructure and data architecture and maintain data dictionary for EHR databases (i.e. development, test, production). In addition, you will create and maintain technical and user system documentation; maintain and develop reports for Agency Nurse Tracking System; develop strategic reports for Borough Nurse Directors for administrative support; assist with developing reports for inventory and equipment tracking requests; develop and convert medical forms from Adobe .pdf to electronic health web forms; update Nurse HR systems from legacy applications to web system; provide ad-hoc reports and develop systems to produce standard Nurse program reports based on pre-specified filter criteria.

PREFERRED SKILLS:

Minimum three years experience hands-on application development, including browser applications, with hands-on development in a production environment with Microsoft Database Server 2005/ISS XML and Web Services; hands-on experience with relational database design and implementation; design and develop custom application and packages; interface with users, management, and programmers regarding technical issues; experience with the development of web applications, querying and reporting facilities Crystal Reports/Enterprise; ability to analyze and understand complex business processes.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Professional/vendor certification(s) in computer applications programming that is required for the position to be filled. In addition, all candidates must have the following:

1. A Baccalaureate degree from an accredited college, and two years of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) experience in computer applications development planning, design, configuration, installation. Troubleshooting, integration, performance monitoring, maintenance, enhancement, and security management; **or**
2. A four-year High School diploma or its educational equivalent and six years of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) information technology experience of which at least 2 must have been as described in "1" below; **or**
3. A Master's degree in computer science or a related field from an accredited college may substitute for one-year experience. However, all candidates must have at least one year satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) information technology experience as described in "1" above.

Incumbents may be required to update existing and/or obtain additional professional industry-standard certification(s) for current and future technical environment(s) in which they may be assigned to work, as determined by the employing agency.
