JOB DESCRIPTION:

The Office of Financial System and Analysis is seeking an experienced Certified IT Developer (applications) to join our IT team. This individual will develop browser-enabled applications in a Microsoft (.Net/VB/SQL Server 2005/IIS) environment for the Bureau of Finance and Planning. The selected candidate will also be responsible to:

- Maintain and enhance existing internal finance applications for the Bureau of Finance and Planning.
- Interface with users of financial systems to gather, understand and implement system requirements.
- Consult on all data integration issues for projects that affect Finance and Planning.
- Create and maintain technical and user system documentation.
- Implement XML data exchanges.

PREFERRED SKILLS:

- Hands-on (*i.e.* not only classroom) experience developing in a Microsoft .Net/VB/SQL Server 2005/IIS environment for production systems (minimum 3 years in addition to any classroom experience).
- Hands-on experience with data security and encryption techniques and issues
- Hands-on experience developing for highly available systems (failover, disaster recovery).
- Hands-on experience defining, implementing and supporting systems of at least the same size and complexity as those for which the Bureau of Finance and Planning is responsible.
- Experience with developing financial systems a plus.
- Hands-on experience with XML data exchange
- Experience working as the primary support staff for critical systems.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Professional/vendor certification(s) in computer applications programming that is required for the position to be filled.

In addition, all candidates must have the following:

1. A Baccalaureate degree from an accredited college, and two years of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) experience in computer applications development planning, design, configuration, installation, troubleshooting, integration, performance monitoring, maintenance, enhancement, and security management;
or
2. A four-year High School diploma or its educational equivalent and six years of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) information technology experience of which at least 2 years must have been as described in (1) above; or
3. A Masters degree in computer science or a related field from an accredited college may substitute for one year of experience. However, all candidates must have at least one year of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) information technology experience as described in (1) above.
