

APPLICATIONS DEVELOPERS

The New York City Police Department is seeking certified IT professionals with experience in applications development to serve as a web developers for the Department's Intranet and Internet applications. These positions will work primarily on a new state -of-the-art crime control center, developing new applications and carrying out test plans. This entails planning, designing, configuring, installing, testing, troubleshooting, and integrating applications; evaluating system performance, and providing technical support for computer application programs; and facilitating security management.

Preferred Skills

Experience in applications development with a strong understanding of Intranet and Internet applications and the software development cycle. Application's development experience using ASP, NET, VB.net, Visual Studio.NET. Knowledge of DB2, SQLServer, XML, XSL, and Web services. Strong analytical and problem solving skills are required to be effective in this position.

Qualification Requirements

Professional/Vendor certification required for this position:

Microsoft Certified Application's Developer for .NET (MCAD).

In addition all candidates must have the following:

1. A Bachelor's Degree and 2 years of full time (not classroom) experience in computer applications development, planning, design, configuration, installation, troubleshooting, integration, performance monitoring, enhancement and security management; or
2. A High School diploma or its educational equivalent and 6 years of full time experience as described in "1" above.
3. A Master's Degree in computer science or a related field may be substituted for 1 year of experience. However, all candidates must have at least 1 year of full time (not classroom) experience as described in "1" above.

Salary ranges from \$61,522 to \$80,506 commensurate with experience and salary history.
