**JOB DESCRIPTION:**

The New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DOHMH), Bureau of Informatics And Information Technology (BIIT), has a vacancy for two Computer Systems Managers/Developers. Under the direction of the Chief Software Architect/Assistant Commissioner, the Computer Systems Manager will be responsible for the development and support of automation systems in support of agency emergency response activities. During public health emergencies, the candidate will be the primary technology support person for planning, logistical, and operational functions, and will perform rapid development of data applications, field-based technology rollout and management. The candidate will also provide technical support for automation projects that have been developed as part of the Home Land Security grant, including the Epidemiological Response System, Environmental Epidemiology Data Exchange Network, and the Geographical Information Systems Center of Excellence. The candidate will also work to develop automation in support of critical agency initiatives that will increase our organizational capacity to manage during emergencies.

**PREFERRED SKILLS:**

Minimum four years experience hands-on application development, including browser-based applications, with two years hands-on development in a production environment with JAVA, XML, MS SQL Server, TOMCAT, APP SERVER.  
Hands-on experience with relational database design and implementation.  
Excellent technical infrastructure skills.  
Demonstrated ability to create application documentation, for technical and user audiences.  
Excellent verbal and written communication skills.  
Knowledge of Crystal Reports a plus.

**QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

1. A Master's degree in computer science from an accredited college and three years of progressively more responsible, full-time, satisfactory experience using mainframe, mini- or micro-computer technology in computer applications programming, systems programming, computer systems development, data telecommunications, data base administration, or planning of data processing, at least 18 months of this experience must have been in an administrative, managerial or executive capacity in the areas of computer applications programming, systems programming, computer systems development, data telecommunications, data base administration, or planning of data processing or in the supervision of staff performing these duties; or
2. A Baccalaureate degree from an accredited college and four years of experience as described in "1" above; or
3. A four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent and six years of experience as described in "1" above; or
4. Education and experience equivalent to "1", "2" or "3" above. However, all candidates must have at least a four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent and must possess at least three years of experience as described in "1" above, including the 18 months of administrative, managerial, executive or supervisory experience as described in "1" above.

**NOTE:** The following types of experience are **not** acceptable: superficial use of preprogrammed software without complex programming, design, implementation or management of the product; use of word processing packages; use of a hand held calculator; primarily the entering or updating of data in a system; the operation of data processing hardware or consoles.
